We have found a beautiful camp facility that offers new and exciting activities for our camp program, and we are excited to share this unique experience with your camper.

All of us at Children's Heart Foundation would like to recognize and thank Sunshine Nevada for being wonderful hosts at Torino Ranch, as they helped create amazing camp memories to last a lifetime for your campers. The reason for our move, is that Sunshine Nevada is also moving three of their camps to Big Bear, California; unfortunately, our campers cannot be in the high elevation. We found a new camp facility that will be perfect for our camper population. Moving forward, Children's Heart Foundation will be handling all of our own camper/volunteer application process and camp management.

Campers who attend Camp Mend-a-Heart must be between the ages of 7-17, be a current heart patient at Children's Heart Center, and have their cardiologist's approval and signed medical forms, completed by May 1, 2020. All applications must be submitted online, through our Camp Doc program. If you are unable to complete the online application, you can come to our offices and we will assist you. We cannot accept printed applications. We have limited spaces available, so once we fill the spaces, campers will be placed on our waitlist. Applications are on a first come first serve basis. Thus completing your form and submitting your camper's documents are of utmost importance and must be completed by the deadline.
